

Invitation encouraging physicians, who have or intend to immigrate to Israel to settle in the Galilee

Procedure extension and update for 2020

The Ministry for the Development of the Periphery, the Negev and the Galilee (hereinafter-the "Ministry") and the Galilee Development Authority (hereinafter – the "Authority") announce their intention to extend the program encouraging immigrant physicians to integrate into the Galilee healthcare system and settle in Galilee. This with the aim to reduce the health-care difference existing between the Galilee and the center of Israel and increase the number of physicians residing in and working in Galilee's healthcare institutions

1. Definitions

- 1.1 "**Grammatical gender.**" For convenience, the procedure is written in the masculine language gender but is intended for both sexes.
- 1.2 "**Ministry**" Ministry for Development of t Periphery, the Negev and the Galilee;
- 1.3 "**Authority**" The Galilee Development Authority;
- 1.4 "**Galilee**" As defined in the Galilee Development Authority Law, 4753- 1993;
- 1.5 "**Healthcare in the Galilee**" Healthcare institutions in the Galilee, including government healthcare institutions, HMO institutions and other healthcare institutions recognized by the Ministry of Health.
- 1.6 "**Immigrant physician**" Holder of healthcare education degree (MD) and holder of an Israeli license to practice medicine or alternatively of an exemption from examination duty according to article 4 (b) (2) of the Physicians Ordinance [New version], 5737- 1976, or according to the Physicians Regulations (conditions for exemption from examination duty), 5748- 1988, which is defined as an immigrant/immigrant citizen as defined by the Ministry of Aliyah and Integration and received immigrant / eligible status between 1.1.2020 to 31.12.2020, or alternatively, it

has received the immigrant / eligible status and less than 2 years have elapsed from the granting date of status or eligibility as an immigrant to the submittal date of the application, holds an immigrant certificate from the Ministry of Aliyah and Integration and the competent entities, moves its residence to one and the Galilee, and integrates in the Galilee healthcare system between 1.1.2020 to 31.12.2020 .

- 1.7 "**Immigrant / Immigrant Citizen**" Immigrant / Immigrant Citizen as defined by the Ministry of Aliyah and Integration who received immigrant / eligible status from 1.1.2020, or alternatively received immigrant / eligible status and less than 2 years have passed from the granting date of status or eligibility as an immigrant to the submittal date of the application, holds an immigrant certificate from the Ministry of Aliyah and Integration and the competent entities, moves its residence to one and the Galilee, and integrates the field of employment relevant to the procedure (healthcare), in the Galilee from 1. 1. 2020 to 31.12.2020.
- 1.8 "**Galilee Resident**" A citizen of the State of Israel, who lives in the Galilee.
- 1.9 "**Applicant**" Any immigrant /immigrant citizen meeting the criteria defined in this document.
- 1.10 "**Assistance for rent** " Monthly assistance for rent payment at a percentage to be defined and for a period to be defined but not exceeding 18 months and 90% of the rent.
- 1.11 "**Assistance for cultural, leisure, and sports activities**" Assistance at a percentage to be defined and for a period to be defined but not exceeding 18 months for purchase of **subscriptions** for cultural, leisure and sports activities that include cultural institutions, cinemas, museums, sports centers, sports clubs, organized sports activities, informal education, Torah culture, in activities and institutions **located in the Galilee**.
- 1.12 "**Cultural institution**" A public institution that receives regular annual support in accordance with section 3A of the Budget Fundamentals

Law, 5745 -1985, for the purpose of producing performances and presenting them to the public located in the Galilee.

- 1.13 **"Cinema"** A business for public entrainment as defined in Section 3 of the Business Licensing Law, 5728- 1968, which holds a legal license to engage in movie screenings and is located in the Galilee.
- 1.14 **"Museum"** As defined in the Museums Law, 5743-1983, and declared by the Minister of Culture and Sport as a recognized museum in the matter of the aforementioned law and which is supported by the State budget and is located in the Galilee.
- 1.15 **"Sports Center"** Someone providing for-profit sports activities and located in the Galilee.
- 1.16 **"Sports Club"** A non-profit corporation for the purpose of conducting sports activities on a defined place located in the Galilee.
- 1.17 **"Organized Sports Activity"** Sports activity organized by a sports association or sports organization, federation or union that takes place in the Galilee.
- 1.18 **"Informal education"** Youth movement, youth club, community center (cultural, youth and sports center), volunteer center, youth councils, enrichment studies, Torah culture, extra curriculum classes, training, summer camps, located and operating in the Galilee.
- 1.19 **"Torah culture"** Activities that take place in the Galilee and are officially recognized by the Department of Torah culture in the Ministry of Education (through support or budgeting).
- 1.20 **"Assistance for car rental "** Assistance at a percentage to be defined and for a period to be defined but not exceeding 4 months for rent of a vehicle for self-driving or by a driver made available to the renter by the lessor, a motorcycle with an engine capacity above 50 cc, a private vehicle, a commercial vehicle including lending, permit to use, make available to another person in any way, when this is done or given for

money consideration except for a vehicle under a hire purchase agreement

- 1.21 **"Assistance for professional activities"** Assistance at a percentage to be defined and for a period to be defined but not exceeding 18 months for purchase of study materials, assistance for conferences and professional training, and purchase of healthcare equipment for the Applicant.
- 1.22 **"Assistance for reinforcing lessons for students"** Assistance at a percentage to be defined and for a period to be defined but not exceeding 18 months for reinforcing lessons, tutoring, educational projects in support of integration of Applicant's children in the education system.
- 1.23 **"Financial grant"** A financial grant to be transferred to the Applicant by a check payable to cash, provided that 18 months have passed since his acceptance to the program.
- 1.24 **"Committee"** A committee composed of representatives of the Ministry of Development of the Periphery, the Negev and the Galilee and the Galilee Development Authority.
- 1.25 **"Person without housing"** The Applicant and his or her current spouse (if any), do not currently have rights in an apartment under construction, including formal registration, in one of the following forms: ownership according to contract, long term lease according to contract, lease, rental under Tenant Protection Law, inheritance, gift, trust agreement, rights to a housing unit in a farm or estate in a community settlement according to a contract or by inheritance, gift or trust.
- 1.26 **"Families"** A married or common-law married couple (where at least one of them is an immigrant physician) with children, including "single-parent families," an immigrant physician with at least one child.
- 1.27 **"Couples"** A married or common-law married couple (where at least one of them is an immigrant physician), without children.
- 1.28 **"Single person"** An immigrant physician, neither married or common-law married, without children

2. Introduction

The Ministry for the Development of the Periphery, the Negev and the Galilee and the Galilee Development Authority have set the goal of encouraging new immigrant physicians to integrate into the healthcare system in the Galilee and to establish their place of residence in the Galilee. The development momentum in the Galilee depends on encouraging settlement in the Galilee localities. High housing cost in the center of Israel is creating a reality where many residents are looking for inexpensive but at the same time quality housing. At the same time, the healthcare system in the Galilee seeks to enroll quality human capital. The procedure presented below constitutes one of the tools used by the Ministry and the Authority for the purpose of encouraging settlement in the Galilee localities, and at the same time attracting high-quality personnel for high demand professions in the healthcare system in the Galilee.

3. General

Persons eligible for benefits under this procedure will receive monthly assistance for rent payment for a period of up to 18 months and an additional basket of benefits for a period of up to 18 months (except in the matter of assistance for car rental which is limited to 4 months). The benefits will be given to eligible persons every half year (6 months) or another period defined by the Galilee Development Authority. (hereinafter - "**Eligible persons**").

The Committee is responsible for implementing this procedure. In determining the assistance, the Committee will act according to principles of equality, proportionality, and reasonableness, while exercising professional and objective discretion, in accordance with the circumstances of the matter and the "first come first served" method. This method applies from the registration day and until the end of the procedure period and completion of the required documents. Receipt of support is subject to the provisions of Order 6.2.0.4 of Code of Finance Economy "Support payments to other entities".

The assistance detailed in this procedure is provided as a supplement to the regular assistance provided by the Ministry of Aliyah and Integration to new immigrants.

4. Objectives of the procedure

To assist immigrant physicians to settle in the Galilee and facilitate their integration in Israel through integrated support from the time of immigration until their



integration into a locality in the Galilee area where they have chosen to live and work, as well as strengthening these areas with high-quality population and increasing the number of physicians living and working in the Galilee. All this in order to improve the healthcare system in the area.

5. **Threshold conditions for eligibility**

- 5.1 The Applicant is an immigrant physician as defined in this procedure.
- 5.2 The Applicant lives in rented housing in the Galilee.
- 5.3 The Applicant and / or his or her spouse (if any) are not owners of an apartment or part of an apartment in the State of Israel.
- 5.4 The Applicant is registered with the competent institutions on behalf of the Ministry of Aliyah and Integration that encourage immigration to the State of Israel, such as the Jewish Agency, Nefesh B'Nefesh, the Zionist Organization and the like.
- 5.5 The Applicant has submitted as part of his application a rental contract on his name and in **addition**, the Applicant has declared, in the wording attached to this procedure, that the rent assistance is requested for the purpose of his housing together with his nuclear family only. The Applicant has also declared that he is aware that his residence and his family's residence in the apartment for which rent assistance was requested is one of the conditions for eligibility under this procedure.
- 5.6 The Applicant has declared in the wording attached to this procedure that assistance for cultural, recreational, sports activities, car rental, reinforcement lessons, professional activity, and the financial grant are requested only for him and/or his family members, as the case may be.

6. **Basket of benefits**

6.1 The basket of benefits for this program includes:

- 6.1.1 Rent support - rent assistance will end after 18 (eighteen) months from the date of admission to the program.
- 6.1.2 Car rental - this assistance benefit will be granted for a period not exceeding 4 (four) months from the date of admission to the program.
- 6.1.3 Assistance for cultural, sports, leisure activities - assistance for these activities will end after 18 (eighteen) months from the date of admission to



the program.

6.1.4 Assistance for reinforcing lessons for immigrant / returning students - assistance for these activities will end after 18 (eighteen) months from the date of admission to the program.

6.1.3 Assistance for professional activities - assistance for these activities will end after 18 (eighteen) months from the date of admission to the program.

6.1.6 Financial Grant - receipt of the grant will occur after 18 (eighteen) months from the date of admission to the program.

6.2 The total amount of the benefits basket

The amount of the benefits basket will be different for family, couple and single person as detailed below:

Family:

Basket of benefits up to the sum of 50,000 NIS (fifty thousand NIS) according to the following division:

1. Assistance for rent - up to 25,000 NIS.
2. Assistance for cultural and leisure activities and / or car rental and / or assistance for professional activities - up to 15,000.NIS
3. Assistance for student reinforcement lessons - up to 5,000 NIS
4. Financial grant - up to 5,000 NIS .

Couples:

Basket of benefits up to the sum of 30,000 NIS (thirty thousand NIS) according to the following division:

1. Assistance for rent - up to 15,000 NIS.
2. Assistance for cultural and leisure activities and / or car rental and / or assistance for professional activities - up to 10,000.NIS
3. Financial grant - up to 5,000 NIS .

Single person:

Basket of benefits up to the sum of 15,000 NIS (fifteen thousand NIS) according to the following division:

1. Assistance for rent - up to 5,000 NIS.
2. Assistance for cultural and leisure activities and / or car rental and / or



assistance for professional activities - up to 5,000 NIS .

3. Financial grant - up to 5,000 NIS.

6.3 Assistance for rent

The goal of rent support to the immigrant physician is to attract and assist him in moving to the Galilee, by means of assistance for rent payments, as a tool to encourage housing, integration and staying in the Galilee. The assistance will be for a period of up to one and a half years (18 months) from the date of admission to the program.

6.4 Assistance for cultural and leisure activities and / or car rental and / or assistance for professional activities

The goal of support to the immigrant physician in cultural and recreational activities is to facilitate his integration into the local community, exposure to the wide variety of life in the Galilee, promote collaborations during free time and support and encourage the cultural, recreational and sporting institutions in the Galilee.

The assistance for cultural, recreational and sports activities will be provided for the purchase of **subscriptions only** for activities and institutions specified in the definitions of this procedure.

It should be emphasized that the location of cultural institutions and leisure activities must be in the Galilee and this condition constitutes a threshold condition for the Authority's assistance for this activity.

It should also be emphasized that the Authority will not recognize the expenses for the purchase of individual tickets but only for subscriptions.

The assistance for cultural, recreational and sports activities will be for a period of up to one and a half years (18 months) from the date of admission to the program.

In addition, the Authority recognizes the difficulty of new immigrants to travel throughout their area of residence in order to complete the bureaucratic procedures prescribed by the law and to exercise all their rights and find proper employment. Therefore, the Authority has decided to recognize assistance for car rental by the immigrant physician as an activity that helps him to integrate into the community quickly and to conclude the procedures relating to being a new



immigrant.

The assistance will be conditioned by physician's undertaking that the car was rented for the purpose of helping his and his nuclear family integration only.

Recognition of this activity will be for a period of up to four months (120 days) from the admission to the program.

In addition, the Authority is interested in assisting the professional integration of the immigrant physician into the healthcare system in the Galilee, and also sees significant value in continuing his career development, even after immigration to Israel. Therefore, the Authority has decided to recognize and contribute to expenses related to immigrant physician's professional activity as an activity that helps him to integrate into his new workplace.

Recognition of this activity will be for a period of up to one and a half years (18 months) from the admission to the program.

6.5 Assistance for student reinforcement lessons

The purpose of the support is to provide an additional solution (in addition to their eligibility as being new immigrants) to the immigrant physician's children as support in their studies and facilitate their integration into the Israeli education system.

The assistance will include recognition of reinforcement lessons, tutorials, educational projects assisting integration in the education system and the like.

It should be noted that higher education scholarship is not included in this section due to the eligibility of new immigrants to this scholarship from the Ministry of Aliyah and Integration.

Recognition of this activity will be for a period of up to one and a half years (18 months) from the admission to the program.

6.6 Receipt of financial grant

The purpose of the support is to provide the immigrant physician with a grant for perseverance, and this after a significant period of time from the date of immigration, settlement in one of the Galilee localities and employment in the healthcare system in the Galilee. The financial grant can be utilized as the applicant sees fit and without restriction to a particular topic/activity.



The grant will be given after one and a half years (18 months) from the date of admission to the program.

7 The application process for participation in the program

7.1 The Authority will publish the extension of the procedure abroad through the Ministry of Aliyah and Integration, the Jewish Agency, the Zionist Organization, the Nefesh B'Nefesh organization and in Israel through the Authority's website. The program will also be distributed during immigration events that will take place abroad during 2019-2020. The procedures will also be sent to all healthcare institutions and to high-tech industries in the Galilee who will be asked to disseminate the procedure by local means.

7.2 Registration to this program **has been extended until 31.12.2020**. Assistance will be approved for any applicant who meets the threshold conditions specified in this procedure, using the "first come first serve" method. Any applicant who meets the threshold conditions will receive rent assistance and the added benefits until the depletion of the budget allocated to the operation of the procedure.

8 Submittal of application and required documents

The applications shall be submitted as detailed below, including attachment of all documents and undertakings detailed below. An application that will not comply with the terms specified and will not include all documents, certificates and undertakings as detailed below, may not be approved. The Authority reserves the right to request the applicants to provide supplementary documents and any other relevant material in order to prove their compliance with the threshold conditions and the provisions of this procedure.

- Application form in the wording attached to the procedure (Appendix A)
- Signed declaration in the wording attached to the procedure (Appendix B)
- Photo of the Immigrant's Certificate from the Ministry of Aliyah and Integration, indicating that Applicant has immigrated to Israel in the budget year 2020 or alternatively during the previous two years (two years before 1.1.2020).
- Copy of a rental contract in one of the Galilee local authorities



- Employment certificate from a healthcare institution located in the Galilee.
- Photo of the ID with the local authority's address and date of birth (including spouse attachment, if applicable, or a marriage certificate).

9 Actual assistance for rent

9.1 The assistance for rent will be provided to each eligible person every half year (6 months), through a personal check, by the Authority.

The rental contract will be presented and reviewed in November, March, and July.

The Authority may change the frequency of actual rent payments and even transfer the payments directly to the bank accounts of those eligible for support.

9.2 Assistance for rent is only for a period of one and a half years (18 months) since the admission to the program and subject to a residence and work in the healthcare system in the Galilee.

9.3 An immigrant physician who is eligible for rent support shall sign a declaration - Appendices B and C detailing all conditions for rent assistance, including conditions for cancellation of assistance for cases where the eligible person does not meet his obligations. In the event that it becomes clear that the eligible person did not meet one of the following conditions: New immigrant, owner of an apartment in Israel, living in the Galilee, working in the Galilee healthcare system, apartment rental in the Galilee, not living in apartment rented by the Applicant in the Galilee, living in apartment purchased by the tenant, the tenant will be obliged to return the full assistance given to him according to the procedure with addition of Interest and linkage to CPI. If it becomes evident to the Authority that the declaration of the eligible person was a false statement, the Authority reserves the right to take legal action against the eligible person using all proceedings available under the law.

10 Assistance for cultural and leisure activities and / or car rental and / or assistance for professional activities

10.1 The assistance for cultural and recreational activities and/or car rental and/or assistance for professional activities will be granted to all eligible persons in November, March, and July (the months of Committee activities) through a personal check, by the Authority and **this is against the presentation of original invoices showing proof that the activity took place in the Galilee (in**



respect with assistance for professional activities, proofs will be required but the assistance will be for activities that may take place anywhere in Israel).

The invoices will be presented and reviewed just before March, July, and November, with the representative of the Galilee Development Authority.

The Authority may change the frequency of actual transfer of contributions for cultural and leisure activities and even transfer the payments directly to the bank accounts of those eligible for support.

10.2 The assistance for cultural, sports and leisure activities and assistance for professional activities is only for a period of one and half years (18 months) from the date of admission of the immigrant physician to the program and subject to residence and work in the healthcare system in the Galilee; while car rental assistance is for a period of up to four months (120 days) from the date of admission to the program.

10.3 An immigrant physician who is eligible for reimbursement of expenses due to assistance for cultural and recreational activities and / or actual car rental and / or assistance for professional activities, shall sign a declaration - Appendices B and D, that specifies all the conditions for assistance for cultural and leisure activities and / or car rental and / or assistance for professional activity, including conditions for cancellation of assistance for the event that the eligible person fails to meet the threshold conditions. In the event that it becomes evident that the eligible person did not meet one of the following conditions:

New immigrant, does not reside in the Galilee, does not work in the Galilee healthcare system, the activity did not take place in the Galilee (except for professional activity), the eligible person does not have original receipts as proof of assistance for these activities, the eligible person will be obliged to repay the full assistance made available to him according to the procedure, with addition of interest and linkage to CPI. If it becomes evident to the Authority that the declaration of the eligible person was a false statement, the Authority reserves the right to take legal action against the eligible person using all proceedings available under the law.

11 Assistance for reinforcement lessons

11.1 The assistance for reinforcement lessons will be granted to all eligible persons in November, March, and July (months of Committee activity) by means of a personal check, by the Authority **and this is against presentation of original tax**



invoices containing proof that the activity took place in the Galilee.

The invoices will be presented and reviewed in March, July, and November, with the representative of the Galilee Development Authority.

The Authority may change the frequency of actual transfer of contributions for cultural and leisure activities and even transfer the payments directly to the bank accounts of those eligible for support.

11.2 Assistance for reinforcement lessons is only for a period of one and a half years (18 months) from the date of admission to the program of the immigrant physician and subject to a residence and work in the healthcare system in the Galilee.

11.3 An immigrant physician who is eligible for reimbursement of expenses due to assistance for reinforcement lessons shall sign a declaration- Appendices B and C detailing all conditions for assistance for reinforcement lessons, including conditions for cancellation of the assistance for cases where the eligible person does not meet his undertakings. In the event that it becomes evident that the eligible person did not meet one of the following conditions: New immigrant, does not live in the Galilee, does not work in the healthcare system in the Galilee, the activity did not take place in the Galilee, the service provider is not a resident of Galilee, the eligible person does not have original receipts as proof for performance of reinforcements, the eligible person is obliged to return the full assistance made available to him according to the procedure, with addition of Interest and linkage to CPI. If it becomes evident to the Authority that the declaration of the eligible person was a false statement, the Authority reserves the right to take legal action against the eligible person using all proceedings available under the law.

12 Financial grant

12.1 The financial grant will be awarded to each eligible person at the end of 18 (eighteen) months from the admission to the program through a personal check, by the Authority.

12.2 The Authority may change the frequency of actual payment transfer and even transfer the payments directly to the bank accounts of those eligible for support.



- 12.3 The financial grant will only be granted at the end of one and a half years from the admission to the program (18 months) and subject to residence and work in the Galilee healthcare system.
- 12.4 If it will be found that the immigrant physician did not meet his obligation under the terms of this procedure, he will be obliged to return the full assistance made available to him according to the procedure, with the addition of interest and linkage to CPI. If it becomes clear to the Authority that the declaration of the eligible person was a false statement, the Authority reserves the right to take legal action against the eligible person using all proceedings available under the law.

13 Additional requirements and supervision

- 13.1 The Authority is entitled to contact the Applicant during the eligibility review in order to receive clarifications to the application or remove uncertainties that may arise during the review of the proposal.
- 13.2 The Authority is entitled to request additional details during the application review process, or any document or information, which they believe is necessary for reviewing the applications.
- 13.3 The Authority reserves the right, independently or through a supervising entity on their behalf, to examine the truth of the applications at the time they are submitted and also after the approval of eligibility. An eligible person that will be found that did not meet the eligibility conditions, as he declared, will be required to return the amounts paid to him with addition of interest and linkage to CPI according to the law. In the event of a false statement, the Authority reserves the right to report to the law-enforcing authorities and take the necessary legal actions.
- 13.4 It should be emphasized that approval of immigrant physicians to the program is conditional upon receipt of a written letter of approval from the Authority and their registration through the organizations encouraging immigration to Israel does not constitute approval of their admission to the program.
- 13.5 An immigrant physician that his admission to the program has been approved, but upon his immigration to Israel, it was found that he did not meet one of the threshold conditions, his eligibility to all program benefits will be



revoked.

- 13.6 The immigrant physician cannot divert the support from the Authority to other topics for which he is seeking support.
- 13.7 If the immigrant physician does not meet one of the threshold conditions, his eligibility for all program benefits will be revoked.
- 13.8 Distribution of quotas among new immigrant physicians will be determined by the Authority which is authorized to reallocate these quotas, without any prior notice and at its sole discretion.

14 The representative of the Authority

- 14.1 The representative of the Galilee Development Authority in charge of implementing this procedure is Mr. Yoav Vaknin, Head of Industry and Employment Department. Inquiries and questions shall be directed to the Authority representative in writing only via email yoav@galil.gov.il during the program period.
- 14.2 The Authority is entitled, at any time, by notice to be published, to change dates, terms, and other conditions relating to this procedure, at its sole discretion.

15 Instructions for submitting applications

- 15.1 The applications shall be submitted through the organizations encouraging immigration to Israel in tabular form including the following data: Full name, marital status, date of birth, country of immigration, family composition, profession, place of work, address e-mail, phone number. After immigrating to Israel, the eligible persons shall forward the program coordinator of the Galilee Development Authority the documents detailed below in this section.
- 15.2 The applications for assistance must be submitted by 31 December 2020 at 15:00 by email to yoav@galil.gov.il for the attention of Mr. Yoav Vaknin, program director. The Applicant must verify receipt of his application by calling 04-9552426.
- 15.3 It is hereby specifically brought to the attention of applicants:
 - 15.3.1 Authority grants according to this procedure will be distributed to applicants on the "first come first served " basis and subject to their compliance to the procedural provisions as outlined above.



15.3.2 Payment of Authority grants according to this procedure are only subject to the existence of an approved budgetary source for each financial year during which the Authority will intend to implement this procedure. Applicants shall not have any allegation and/or claim and/or demand against the Authority for failure to accept said applications due to a lack of source and/or budget approval.

15.3.3 Payment to the Applicant of the grant and / or contributions will only be made against presentation of receipts for actual expenses and in a proportional manner
